When to Wash/Sanitize Hands

- 1. Children and staff will wash their hands or use hand sanitizer often, making sure to wash all surfaces of their hands (e.g., front and back, wrists, between fingers).
- 2. Reinforce to staff and children that they must be regularly washing their hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and **should wash hands whenever the following** criteria are met:
 - a. Upon entry into and exit from classroom
 - b. When coming in to the program space from outside activities
 - c. Before and after eating
 - d. After sneezing, coughing or nose blowing
 - e. After using restroom
 - f. Before handling food
 - g. After touching or cleaning surfaces that may be contaminated
